Tech Leader (Individual or Company) of the Year Nomination Form

Nomination Forms Must Be Received No Later Than November 8, 2019

The Gorge Technology Alliance (GTA) is pleased to announce the 2019 GTA Awards, which will include the Tech Leader of the Year award and the STEM Education Leader of the Year award. Both awards will be presented at the annual Gorge Technology Alliance Winter Party on December 10, 2019.

The Tech Leader (Individual or Company) of the Year award is intended to recognize outstanding achievement on the part of an individual or company that principally provides technology products, services, or support in the Columbia River Gorge. All technology sectors are eligible, as are sectors not traditionally characterized as technological if the individual/company has an extraordinary commitment to innovation or using technology.

Criteria:

1. Presented to the nominated tech individual or tech company with the largest positive impact on the tech community in the Columbia River Gorge, as judged by the GTA Board of Directors. Only complete nomination forms will be considered.
2. This award will consider all accomplishments **over the past year (October 1, 2018 to September 30, 2019)** which could include the success of new product introductions, community involvement, and impacts on industry trends.
3. The individual or company should be recognized as a leader in the Columbia River Gorge.
4. The individual or company should be in a position to accept the award and to represent the tech community in the Columbia River Gorge in a positive light for the foreseeable future.
5. Individuals or companies are not required to be GTA members to be eligible.
6. Companies must derive the majority of their revenue through provision of products or services that would be considered technology-based. Service providers, even those who provide services to companies in the technology field, are not specifically eligible, unless they have an extraordinary commitment to innovation or using technology.
7. Nominated individuals must work and companies must be headquartered in the five-county Columbia River Gorge or have the majority of their activities or revenue generated from activities (manufacturing, development, etc.) from within the region. A major division or business unit of a company headquartered elsewhere may apply, in which case they will be judged based upon the activities of the local division.
8. Individuals and companies are not required to be members of the GTA to be eligible.
